

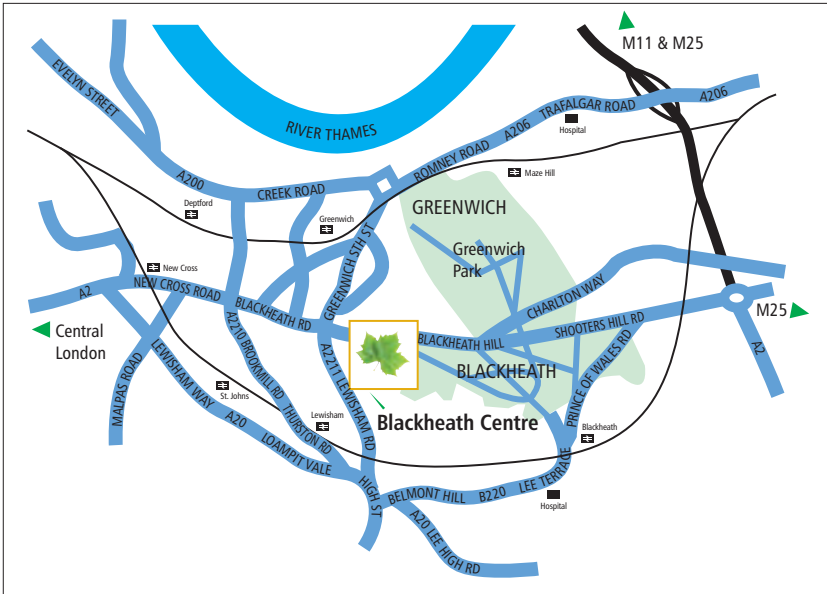
HOW TO FIND US

By Car: Follow the A2 from Central London or, from the M25, take the A2 or M11. The entrance to the centre is on the south side of Blackheath Hill.

By Rail: Take the train from Charing Cross or London Bridge stations to Greenwich station, then the 386 bus from Greenwich to the unit. Buses also available from Lewisham station. Serviced by DLR and Southeastern Rail from Kent to Lewisham.

By Bus: Bus route 53 runs from Central London.

By Air: London City airport via DLR to Lewisham.

Specialist services:

THAMES BRAIN INJURY REHABILITATION UNIT (18 beds)

For adults with cognitive impairments as a result of an acquired/traumatic brain injury or complex neurological disability, including people detained under the Mental Health Act. Examples include changes in behaviour, aggressive or impulsive behaviours, poor compliance with therapy, co-morbid psychiatric disorder.

HEATHSIDE NEURODISABILITY UNIT (18 beds)

Provides rehabilitation for individuals with a brain injury of any cause and/or progressive neurological conditions. Treating people with complex physical disabilities, including tracheostomy, swallowing problems and people with low levels of arousal.

- Q Is your client medically stable and would benefit from an **intensive multi-disciplinary rehabilitation programme**?
